DISTRICT SPORTS



On Monday we attended District Sports for Years 3/4 and on Thursday we attended with Years 5/6. The events took place at Woking Athletics track in Sheerwater.

10 children from years 3/4 - Drew, Finley, Tom, Joshua, Ben, Sarah, Charlotte, Anaya, Hannah and Scarlett - and 10 children from year 5 (year 6 are away on their residential trip) - Nate, Hayden, Max, Will, Miguel, Grace, Ava, Charlotte, Alice and Olivia - took part in events.

In the 3/4 event each child had to sprint 50m, run 400m, throw a vortex and do a standing long jump. In the 5/6 event they had to sprint 75m, run 600m, throw a vortex and do a standing jump. There was then a shuttle relay at the end of the afternoon.

All the children really pushed themselves and performed to the best of their abilities. We had lots of first and second places. We definitely dominated the middle distance races often taking first place. Our performance in the vortex in both age groups was extremely strong. We had one of the furthest jumps in the standing jump again in both age groups.



We do not yet know the full results. There will be an overall winner for years 3/4 and also for years 5/6. Individual winners will also be confirmed. Every event was timed or measured, so we do not yet know how our times will compare to the events that took place in the morning (both year groups were divided into either morning or afternoon events to make the event run quickly and smoothly). We shall wait and see!
