‘Early Bird’ Breakfast Club

The ‘Early Bird’ Breakfast Club is provided by Pyrford Church of England (Aided) Primary School for pupils attending the school. The Breakfast Club is open each day from 7.45 to 8.45 am. At the end of each session, children are directed to their classrooms with supervision being provided for the youngest.

The Breakfast Club is held in the Friends Room with access via the side gate and outside door to the Friends (not through the main entrance). It is run by experienced members of staff and covered by existing school policies. There are high expectations of pupils behaviour in the school and this extends to the Breakfast Club. Pupils who do not comply with the rules, will be unable to attend.

A healthy breakfast consisting of cereals, toast, fresh fruit, yogurts, fruit juice and milk is on offer each day. On special occasions the children are given an opportunity to experience other breakfast foods, such as the school’s “One World Week” celebrations.

In addition to providing breakfast, daily activities are planned for the children. These vary from quiet reading and writing to board games, construction activities, craft projects and ball games and exploration in the Mediterranean Garden. Our aim is to provide for a range of interests and a good quality start to the day in a warm and friendly environment.

We charge £3.85 per session and this includes the cost of breakfast. It is requested that bookings and payments be made in advance of the upcoming half-term. Places are limited, so early booking is advised to avoid disappointment. Parents requiring ‘one off’ sessions will only be able to secure a booking if there are any vacancies.
