

### Headteacher's Letter


Good morning and Happy New Year to you all!

I know that a good number of you have been affected by the virus over the last few days and weeks and wish you a speedy recovery. We have had a good return to school and the children and staff have been pleased to see each other. Attendance from staff and pupils has been lower than usual but certainly nothing to panic about just yet! We will see how the next few weeks pan out. In school we are continuing with our usual Covid protocols as before the Christmas break.
