Is your child starting school in September 2024?

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 you will need to apply for a school place between **30 October 2023** and **15 January 2024.**

Is your child in year 2? If your child attends an infant school you will need to apply for a place at a junior school or a primary school with a year 3 intake.

Apply online between 30 October 2023 and 15 January 2024



The closing date for Reception applications for September 2024 entry is **15** January 2024. Please remember that you still need to apply if your child is at Squirrels or is a sibling of a child already in the school.

Surrey encourage online applications via <u>https://www.eadmissions.org.uk/</u> <u>eAdmissions/app</u>, however you can also request a paper application form or seek impartial help in completing an application via the Surrey Schools & Childcare Service (0300 200 1004, Mon-Fri 9am-5pm). Full information is available on Surrey's website at <u>www.surreycc.gov.uk/primaryadmissions</u>.

Applications received after the closing date without good reason will be treated as late and will not be considered until all on time applications have been processed. This may jeopardise the chance of you being offered one of your preferred schools for your child. Surrey will **only** consider an application as ontime even if it has been made late if there is a genuine reason why the application could not reasonably have been made before the closing date.
