
Geography

In Geography, the children will learn to describe and understand key aspects of physical geography: rivers. They will be able to discuss the main features of a river and we will complete some local field work.

<u>English</u>

This half term, the children will be reading a non-fiction book called Shackleton. The children will be writing an explanation text of a compass, after which they will write a story chapter.



<u>PE</u>

Dance - Hakka and Street dance

Netball – Working as a team to improve group tactics and game play.

Computing

This term, the children will be learning coding – creating games using sequence, selection and repetition in Scratch including decomposition of tasks, creating sprites.



<u>PSHE</u>

The children will be exploring how we should value differences in each other, recognise positive attributes and bullying and develop coping strategies. Discuss what is 'normal' and challenge media stereotypes.

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<u>RE</u>

In RE, the children will explore the connections as most Christians see them between prophecies in the Old Testament about the Messiah, and events from the life of Jesus.

<u>DT</u>

In Design Technology the children will be researching, designing and making their own slippers, using inspiration from footwear.





<u>Science</u>

In Science, the children will recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. They will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. They will also be able to explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths the children will revise and build on their understanding of fractions, including equivalent fractions and simplifying fractions, and also multiplying and dividing fractions. They will also build on improving their fluency and application in reasoning and problem-solving questions.

<u>Music</u>

The children will explore composition to represent the festival of colour.

<u>Spanish</u>

The children will learn how to name different clothes in Spanish across each season and food and eating out.
