

### Physical Development

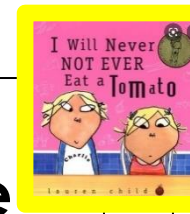
- We will continue to develop our fine motor skills through handwriting practise and fine motor exercises in our play.

We are learning all about traditional tales, familiar stories and traditional tales from another culture

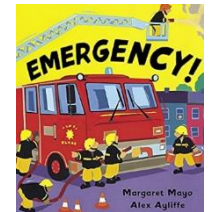
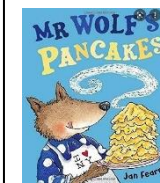


### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

### Communication and Language

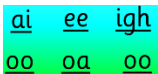
- We will be learning familiar stories and identifying the repeated refrains.
- We will practise retelling familiar stories using picture prompts to expand our vocabulary and sequencing skills.
- We will identify 'interesting' language when reading stories and try to use this in our role play and then writing or retelling of stories.



### Literacy

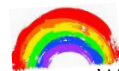
We use a different book each week to base our learning around. These link to our topic.

- We will continue learning new phonic sounds and to read and write more 'tricky words'
- We are learning digraphs and trigraphs
- We will start to apply our sounds in our writing – writing phonetically plausible attempts independently.
- We will write instructions, lists and non-fiction facts.



### Understanding the World

- In science we are learning about healthy eating and oral health.
- We are also learning about the season spring and looking at the changes in the season
- In RE we are learning about what is special for us in our lives and why Easter is a special time for Christians.
- We are exploring the history of the NHS and how fire fighters fought fires in the past.



### Expressive Arts and Design

- We are exploring box craft
- We will learn different joining techniques
- We will learn how to decorate models



### Maths
