Geography

In Geography, we will be looking at our unit, Enough for Everyone, which includes types of settlement, where our power comes from and learning about renewable energy. We finish with investigating where our food comes from and find out about Fair Trade.

English

This term, we are reading 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo and using this as inspiration for our writing. Focussing on creative story writing, they will be telling the story of Michael meeting Kensuke for the first time on his island in the Pacific, after which they will be writing a Non-Chronological Report about the fauna of the island and writing details of their own unique creature.

Computing

In this unit, we will explore how data is transferred over the internet, focussing on the makeup and structure of data packets. We will finally look at how the internet facilitates online communication and staying safe.

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<u>RE</u>

In RE, the children will explore, what difference it makes to belong to God's Kingdom for Christians When we will explore what different the Holy Spirit makes, study the Lord's Prayer and explore beliefs about life after death.

DT

In Design Technology our unit is Food Technology and we will be studying world food and have an understanding seasonality, and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed. We will also be investigating how spices and herbs are used in world food.

Science

In Science, we will be studying
Healthy Lifestyles, and how to keep

and health.

Maths

Our learning in Maths will be learning algebra; ratio and proportion; fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also revise and build on their understanding of volume and the conversion of units, in addition to, reasoning and problem-solving questions

Music

This Japanese inspired topic looks at the springtime festival of Hanami, Children will use descriptive vocabulary to create a Haiku and put it to music.

Spanish

The children will learn how to tell the time and talk about their daily routines; describe the weather.
