Welcome to Year 2 and the Autumn Term!

We wanted to update you on a few things you may need to know this term.

Reading:

We use a reading programme called Routes to Reading which follows on from the Success for All phonics scheme. This programme runs on a 2-week cycle and we have already started our first book in class. They will be bringing this book home at the end of Week 3 (w/b 15th September). In the meantime, your child will be bringing home a familiar book in order to practise fluency.

Spelling:

We follow an online spelling scheme called Spelling with the Jungle Club, which also follows on from Success for All phonics.

Year 2:

In Year 2, the children are allowed to wear a watch. They need to be able to remove their watch for PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays, so you may prefer your child to leave their watch at home on these days.

Maths

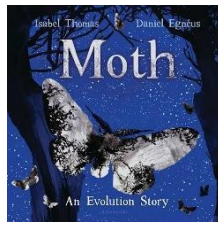
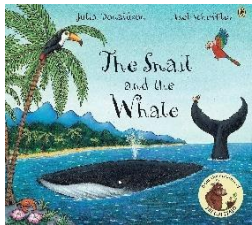
- Place value – numbers up to 100

- Shapes, jumps & apparatus

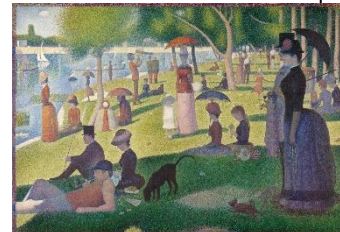
Computing
