

Geography

In Geography, we are learning about Land use across the UK. We will be looking at the difference between agricultural and urban land use and completing a case study on these areas.

This Half Term our Discovery learning topics are:

Science

In Science, we will learn about the water cycle. We will be focusing on evaporation, condensation and precipitation. We will be creating our own mini water cycle to observe some of the processes.

English

This half term, we are reading a book called Varjak Paw, by SF Said. The children will write discussions, poetry and character descriptions about the cats



PSHE

The children will learn about rights and responsibilities, including the role of a bystander.

Maths

The children will be learning about fractions. Converting from improper to mixed and vice versa as well as adding and subtracting fractions.

We will also be looking at tenths and hundredths as fractions and decimals

At the end of the half term will be move on to dividing by 10 and 100.



RE

In RE, we are focusing on communion. We will explore whether this is a celebration, or an act or remembrance. The children will learn that the symbols of communion are a way of remembering Jesus and his sacrifice.

PE

Gym –Developing balances, rolls and jumps and using these in more complex sequences.

Cricket – we have a cricket coach working with the children this term.

Computing

This term, the children are learning about the digital devices and how computers are connected.



Art

The children will learn to collagraph print. They will experiment with printing using different objects, use natural and manmade printing tools to create repeated patterns



Music

The children will continue to learn their instrument. The children will be singing a range of songs for the performance.
