

Physical Development

- We will continue to develop our handwriting and pencil hold to develop fluency and stamina.
- In PE we will be learning skills needed to play games e.g. speeding up and slowing down, making use of space and working as a team
- We will be having weekly swimming lessons.



Literacy

We use a different book each week to base our learning around. These link to our topic.

- We will continue learning our sounds and learn to read and write more 'tricky words'
- We will continue to read books that match the sounds we have been taught to practise and consolidate our reading skills
- We will continue to apply our sounds in our writing – writing phonetically plausible attempts independently and tricky words.

- We will be thinking about moving on to our next class and preparing for the change

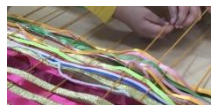
Understanding the World

- In Science we are learning about growing and changing in plants and animals
- We will be learning about minibeasts and lifecycles.
- We are also learning about Summer and looking at the changes in the season
- In RE we are learning about how to look after the world God created.
- We are exploring changes over time in our own lives and how we have changed.



Expressive Arts and Design

- We are exploring textiles and weaving
- We are exploring being imaginative through role play and using familiar stories to influence our role play language and narratives.



Communication and Language

- We will be learning specific vocabulary linked to our topics and learning facts about animals and plants.
- We will practise retelling familiar stories using picture prompts to expand our vocabulary and sequencing skills.
- We will identify 'interesting' language when reading stories and try to use this in our role play and then writing or retelling of stories.

Maths

We follow 'White Rose Maths' scheme of work and also use the 'Numberblocks' resources from NCTEM

This term's topic is 'sharing and grouping' in number and 'visualise and build' in shape and will cover;

- Sharing and grouping
- Match, rotate, and manipulate shape.
- Visualising and building with shapes.
- Mapping direction
- Deepening understanding of pattern and relationships.
