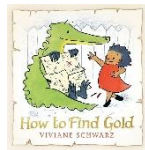
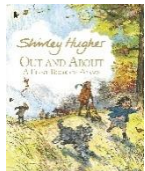


- Identifying mammals, reptiles, amphibians and pets
