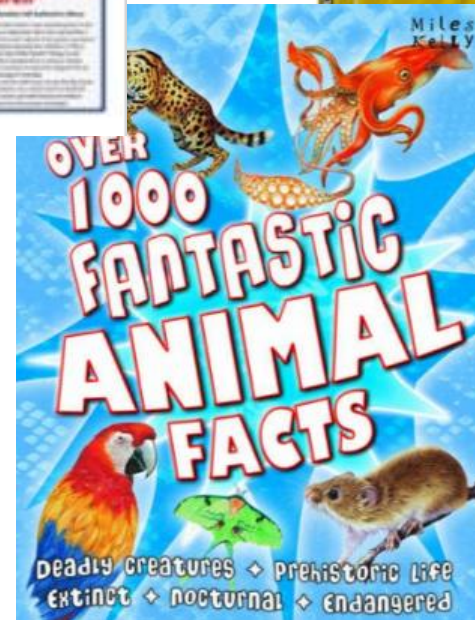
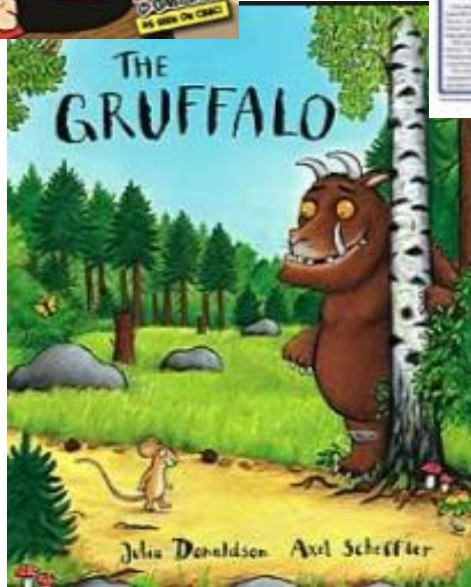
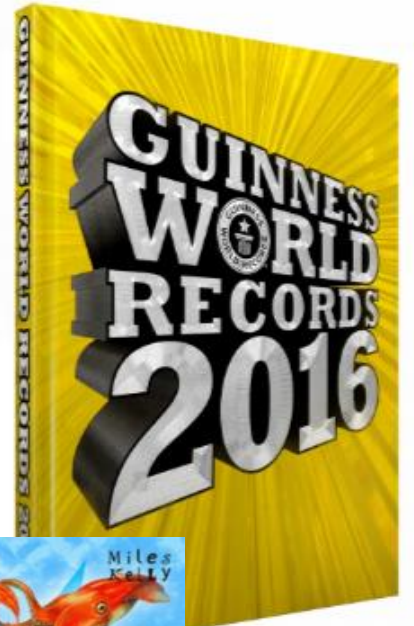
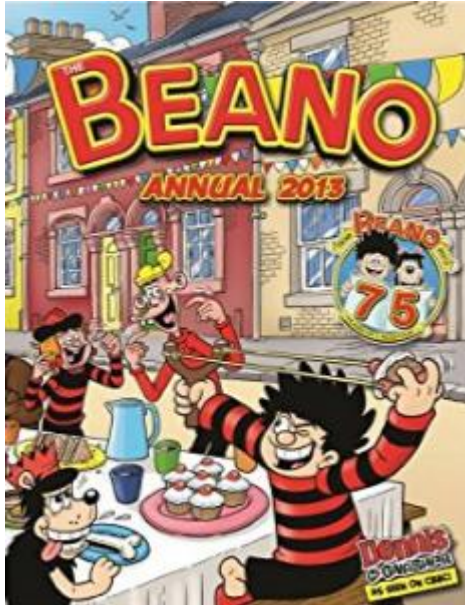


Reading
