



PTA SPENDING PLANS

Following the incredible success of recent fundraising, the PTA committee have been busy discussing plans for spending on a variety of long and short term projects. Based on the feedback from the parents questionnaire last term, the following six areas have been agreed as priorities for funding:

- Music and Arts Pod. An additional learning room offering dedicated space for arts and music practice, which is currently not available in school meaning children must use corridors **£TBC**
- Educational activity for Years 5 & 6 in recognition that they (and their parents) have raised much of the PTA money over the last two years and will derive less benefit from spend, especially longer term projects **£1000**
- Purchase of a "story-telling chair" for the school garden, in memory of Mrs Edis **£400**
- Kits and equipment for the Running Club and Football Club **£800+**
- Additional play equipment in the Year 1&2 play area **£5000**
- Development of outdoor play area for Squirrels Nursery **£2500**
