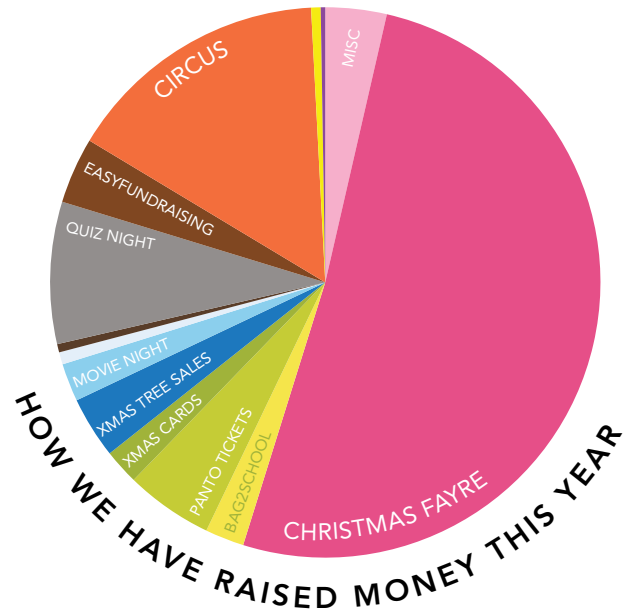

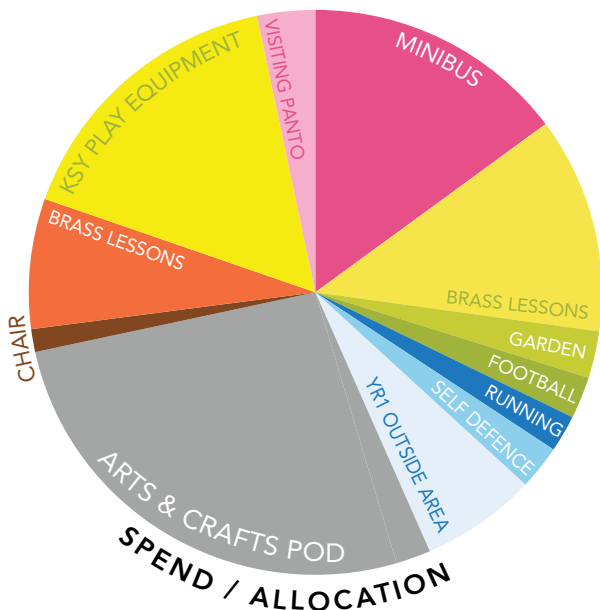
THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING US THIS YEAR!
