Coming to School

- Start time: Please drop off your child at 8:30
- Please make sure your child is given ALL their belongings BEFORE arriving at the gate, please try to avoid long goodbyes
- A member of staff will greet your child at one of the 2 school entrances (please use the same entrance each day)
- Children will then follow the one-way system to their class spots where they will be met by an adult from their bubble and led to their classroom
- When your child comes into the classroom they will put away their belongings and wash their hands before settling to the morning activity

Collection from School

- End time: 3.00
- A member of staff will lead the children to stand on collection spots on the playground they arrived at that morning
- Please enter at the same gate you dropped off and follow the one-way system to collect your child from their spot
- Please ask your child to carry their belongings until they leave the premises
- Please move swiftly to avoid congestion and adhere to the social distancing rules

Mixing within the bubble

- The KS1 bubble consists of the children in both Year 1 and Year 2 and includes all the staff working with these children
- Children will share the same before and after school facilities and the same playground at morning break
- Year 2 will use the allocated toilets upstairs (which will be cleaned during the day)
- Year 2 will also have access to their own outside area throughout the day
- The children will be encouraged to stay within their own class during indoor learning time

What do we need to bring to school?

- Water bottle
- Coat
- Hat
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- Small pencil case containing:
 - Writing pencils
 - Rubber
 - Sharpener
 - Glue stick
 - Coloured Pencils
 - Felt Pens (optional)
- Book-bag or Small rucksack (that can be hung on the back of their chair)
- Healthy **morning snack** (no nuts)
- Please name ALL items
- Please give ALL items to your child to carry BEFORE reaching the drop off point to help avoid congestion
- Please do not bring any additional items from home into school

PE Day

- Children will no longer be getting changed for PE in school.
- Children in Year 1 will come to school in their PE kit on Wednesday
- Children in **Year 2** will come to school in their PE kit on **Thursday**
- They will wear their kit all day
- Children need to wear:
 - Navy Tracksuit (Navy Blue jumper/hoodie & Navy Blue tracksuit bottoms or shorts)
 - Red school PE T-shirt
 - Trainers
